— TLOS & SAKLIKENT —

As one of the six principal cities of Lycia, Tlos once bore the title under the Roman empire of 'the very brilliant metropolis of the Lycian nation'. It is one of the oldest and largest settlements of Lycia and was eventually inhabited by Ottoman Turks, one of the few Lycian cities to continue its existence through the 19th century.

The influence of many cultures upon Tlos has resulted in an interesting collage of structures. It is a romantic place with lush nature and many of the buildings are vine-covered, it would have been the perfect location for any romantic painter.

Tomb of Bellerophon, stadium, market hall, bath and amphitheatre are the features of the Tlos. The view from the top is spectacular with amazing 360 degree views over the Xanthos valley and the surrounding mountains.

Saklıkent Canyon is the second largest canyon in Europe. The Canyon is 300 meters deep and 18 km long, resulting from the abrasion of the rocks by flowing waters over thousands of years. As the level of water rises during winter months, visitors can enter the canyon only in the summer. Four kilometers of the canyon are walkable after April.
